**CONDITIONS.**

1. All entries are free and open to members of the Orchid Society of NSW Inc., and it's affiliated Societies, Interstate Orchid Societies, Overseas Orchid Societies and Australasian Council of Native Orchid Societies.
2. Although there will be tight security at the Racecourse, entries are received on the basis that the sponsor shall not be responsible for any loss, destruction or damage to such exhibits, and the exhibitor shall have no claim whatsoever against the sponsor or any of the Societies involved.
3. Plants competing for prizes shall have been owned by, and in the possession of the exhibitor for the preceding six months.
4. All plants exhibited must be healthy and free of pests and diseases. The Show Marshall's decision in this matter shall be final.
5. All plants and pots must be clean. All tabletop displays will be dressed in black only.
6. The Show Marshall and Committee reserve the right to reject, remove or rearrange any exhibit. Extra classes may be created at the discretion of the Committee.
7. All plants entered must be correctly and clearly labelled with the name of the plant. Labels should be legible to the public.
8. Judging shall be in accordance with the rules as set out by the Show Committee in this Schedule and or in accordance with the standards and by-laws the of the Orchid Society of N.S.W. Inc. The Judges' decision is final, no correspondence or debate will be entered into.
9. An exhibitor shall not remove plants, an exhibit or part thereof before the end of the show, without the permission of the Show Marshall or Show Committee prior to the show.
10. Cattleya means Cattleya or hybrids between Cattleya and one or more of Brassovola, Laelia and Sophronitis.
11. Laeliinae Alliance shall include all combinations in the alliance but does not include those in Condition 10.
12. No flower or fruit other than Orchids, Anthuriums or Bromeliads may be used in any display.
13. Exhibitors may use ferns/foliage plants to embellish exhibits. Such plants will not be taken into consideration in judging, except for decorative effect in display classes.
14. Award of the OSNSW Gold Medal, donated by the Orchid Society of NSW is conditional upon the owner giving the winning seedling the varietal name **'Gosford Gold'**
15. Entries in Seedling classes and species classes **MUST** be notified to the Show Marshall before judging starts. Seedlings and species orchids not correctly nominated will not be judged.
16. A seedling shall mean the complete plant grown from seed and flowering for the first time. Plants that have been grown-on or divided prior to being exhibited on the showbench are not eligible to be shown as seedlings.
17. Plants shall be in position ready for judging at 6:00pm on Fridayday, 31st July, 2009 Exhibitors intending to enter displays in classes 1 - 6 inclusive must inform the Show Marshall no later than 1st April, 2009.
18. Shall include Masdevallia, Dracula and all other hybrids within the alliance.
19. Zygopetalum alliance shall include all combinations in the alliance including Bollea, Cochleanthes, Huntleya, Pescatorea, Promenaea & Zygopetalum
20. Includes all genera in the Laeliinea alliance other than Cattleya & Laelia.
21. Includes all Monopodial genera other than Phalaenopsis and Vanda such as Angraecoids and other Vandaceous genera.
22. Includes all Pleurothallid genera other than Masdevallia and Dracula.
23. Includes Orchids from Fiji, Vanuatu, Timor, Irian Jaya, New Caledonia, Solomon Islands, Papua New Guinea and New Zealand.
24. Orchids must predominate, any greenery and other flowers may be used.
25. Entries may be sold – 15% commission will be charged on all sales. Sold items are to remain in the display and may be collected after 3pm Sunday.
26. The sponsor reserves the right to photograph for its own purposes any exhibit in the show.
27. Display positions will be balloted and must be manned during judging. Exhibitors are to ensure that displays present a neat and tidy appearance from ground level.

28. **Major prizes will be presented on Saturday, 1st August 2009.**
