Show Committee report

Southern Spectacular: 9th to 11th October 2009 - Chris Dalrymple advised members that there had been a meeting of the SOS Committee last week, and that preparations were on track for the event. He said that the Show Schedule would be produced by the end of July, and would be available on the OSNSW website.

St. Ives' Village: 18th to 21st June 2009 - Geoff advised members that the St. Ives Village show had been a great success. He thanked all those members who supported the event. Garrie Bromley and Geoff Fulcher then handed out monies for prizes and sales to recipients.

Royal Botanic Gardens: Ian to report to members at the July meeting.

Orchids out West: 30th April - 2nd May 2010

Geoff related some of the 2009 OOW Chairman's final report, saying that whilst the show was an enormous success, the fact that OOW clashed with the Hawkesbury show was not a good idea for crowd numbers, and would be avoided in future. The Show next year will be from 30th April to 2nd May, with the Hawkesbury Ag show on the weekend before. The venue has been booked, and will expand to include the whole area of the corporate building. The Hawkesbury Ag show will not clash either in 2011. The participating clubs, Commercial Nurseries and Individuals who put on displays this year again excelled with the amount and quality of outstanding plants.

Orchids at Ermington : 19th - 20th September 2009

Geoff reminded members that the Ermington weekend would be set up as a benching similar to regular monthly meetings, with the addition of a couple of small displays. There will also be a large sales table of plants and accessories.
