Sadly the mission was not successful in finding the species, but the account of Stewart's sometimes harrowing adventures in a land seen by so few was enthralling. We are so lucky to have seen the wonderful flora (some Nepenthes which are so rare they had not been seen for many years) and rare and dangerous fauna.
